Format There will be no practice bowls or ends.
Order of Play – 1st end: alphabetic (surname), then by scoring: high to low.
The mat line will be always placed at 2 metres from the rear ditch.
The jack will not be centred and is in play as long as it is in bounds, past the hog line and not in the ditch. Otherwise the next player delivers the jack. If still not in play, the jack will be placed at the 2 metre mark.
Once play starts, a dead jack will be placed at the 2 metre mark.
No walking to the head until all bowls delivered.
End Scoring: 3 for shot bowl, 2 for second closest bowl, 1 for third closest bowl.
Touchers are not marked.
Game points awarded for 3 person Cutthroat, 3 points for a win, 1 point for second place, 1 point each for 1st place tie.
Game points awarded for 2 person Cutthroat, 3 points for a win, 1 point for a tie
