Ranking of teams would be based on 3 points for a win, 1 point for a tie, with point ties broken first by ends won and then by points for minus points against. Burnt ends: Jack will be reset to the 2 metre mark at centreline. The Laws of the Sport of Bowls, crystal mark 4th edition will apply, except where noted.
