Play scheduling and Ranking:

Team ranking from highest to lowest will first be determined by the team's point score, then by ends won, then by shots for minus shots against. Rankings shall not include the extra end if played.

Teams to be matched in the next game are those most closely ranked. Ties will be decided by the flip of a coin.

Teams will not play the same team again. Should this be the initial result, a different pairing with the closest possible ranking will be used.

The event winning team will have won all their games and have the highest point score. If there is a tie the winning team will have the most total ends won and if still tied the winning team will be the team with the highest total shots for minus shots against. The runner up team will have the next highest ranking using points awarded and the above tying criteria. If there is a clear winning team the runner up team will have lost to the winning team in the final match up. Other placements will be determined in a like manner in descending order.
