There will be a maximum of 48 players. A waitlist will be created. If necessary, players will be dropped to ensure an even number of teams. Teams are drawn randomly. **Special invitation to the 2024/2025 Novices.**

The Games committee will seed teams for the 1st game. In successive games, teams are matched against each other in order of ranking, with winners playing each other. In case of a tie, an extra end will be played but rankings will be determined using only the score at the end of the regular game.

Rankings will be by games won, then by ends won, and then by differential.

With 16 teams, there will be a single undefeated team after 4 games. The lone undefeated team will be the tournament winner and the losing team in the final will be declared the runner up. If fewer than 16 teams enter, there may be a single undefeated team after 3 games and the tournament will be declared over.

Comments:	The goal is competitive play for all teams. The draw master will ensure that teams do not play each other twice. The tournament winning and losing (the runner-up) teams will receive prizes. If four games have been played, additional prizes will be awarded to the highest ranked non-finalist team with 1 loss, the highest ranked team with 2 losses, and the highest ranked team with 3 losses. If the tournament is declared over after 3 games, additional prizes will be awarded to the highest ranked non-finalist team with 1 loss, the highest ranked team with 2 losses, and a team chosen by a random draw.
