The Captain's Cup winner will have played at least 10 games and have the highest average score. Scoring for Scotch Pairs: 3 points for a win and 1 point for a tie Scoring for 3 person C/T: 3 points for a win, 1 point 2 <sup>nd</sup> pl, 1 point ea for 1 <sup>st</sup> pl tie Scoring for 2 person C/T: 3 points for a win, 1 point ea for a tie Any end of season tie for the Cup champion will be broken by a 3 end singles game at the end of the last regular game.
