Date(s) of Play	Wednesday, September 9 to Sunday, September 13, 2026
Event Time(s)	Wednesday, Sept. 9 – trial ends at 4:45 pm (only if there are more than 16 players) Thursday, Sept. 10 – trial ends at 4:45 pm Friday, Sept. 11 – trial ends 4:45 pm Saturday, Sept. 12 – trial ends 9:00 am, 11:30 and 2:00 (max 2 games per player) Sunday, Sept. 13 – trial ends 9:45 top 4 teams - 1 vs 4 and 2 vs 3 Sunday, Sept. 13 – trial ends 12:30 Men's Club Champion games. Winners of earlier game play and losers of early game play. This game may begin earlier if competitors, the umpire, and the markers are in agreement. Draw for this tournament will be Tuesday, September 8 at 12:00. If you are not in attendance, the Games Committee will draw for you.
Eligibility:	All 2025 or earlier active male SLBC members. (No 2026 Novices)

Format:	Each player will play four games to determine the top four for the championship playoffs. Player can only visit the head after they deliver their third bowl. For the random draw the Trueman/Buchholz tie breaking system will be used. If a tie remains after Trueman/Buchholz is applied the following tie breaker order will be used: total point differential then a 2 end playoff (with an extra end if required). Trial ends (2 bowls up and back) will commence 15 minutes prior to bell start. Three points for a win; zero for a loss. Burnt jack to be set to the 2-metre mark on centre line. The <i>Laws of Sport of Bowls, Crystal Mark 4th Edition 2022</i> will apply except as modified herein.
Length of Games:	To 15 shots from bell start. No time limit.
Umpire and Markers:	Yes. Markers, please register online.
Apparel:	Club colours or whites.
Food:	Coffee, tea and snacks available (\$) on Saturday; bring your own lunch.
